HOW TO USE:

Shake well before using. Keep agitated during use. DO NOT spray when shade temperatures exceed 32°C (36°C for citrus). DO NOT spray when soil is dry and plants are suffering from moisture stress. DO NOT apply for at least one month after sulphur or lime sulphur spray.

| SITUATION | PEST | HOW TO APPLY |

| Citrus (except Glen Retreat mandarins) | Citrus leafminer | During growth flushes (usually spring and early-mid autumn) spray every 5-14 days as required. Spray when immature leaves are 4 cm long. Spray thoroughly including undersides of foliage. Do not spray more than 8 times per season. Avoid spraying citrus in late autumn or winter. |
| | Red Scale | Apply in December and/or February/March. Spray thoroughly including the undersides of foliage. Avoid spraying in late autumn or winter. |
| | White Wax Scale Pink Wax Scale | Apply December/early January. Spray thoroughly including the undersides of foliage. Avoid spraying in late autumn or winter. |
| | Black Scale | Apply mid December/early January. Repeat in February. Spray thoroughly including the undersides of foliage. Avoid spraying in late autumn or winter. |
| | Soft Brown Scale | Apply January/April. Spray thoroughly including the undersides of foliage. Avoid spraying in late autumn or winter. |
| Grapes | Grapevine Scale | May be controlled by spraying the dormant vines in winter, preferably after pruning. Spray thoroughly, including the undersides of foliage. |
| Roses, Indoor and Outdoor Ornamentals | Scale, Aphids, Whitefly (NOT QLD), Mealy Bugs | Spray thoroughly including the undersides of foliage, as required. Spray lightly on delicate indoor plants such as maidenhair ferns. |
| Stone Fruit (eg: Peaches, Plums, Apricots) Pome Fruit (eg: Pears & Apples) | San Jose Scale, Oyster Shell Scale, Spider Mites | Spray during winter before bud burst. Spray thoroughly including the undersides of foliage. |

WITHOLDING PERIOD: DO NOT PICK EDIBLE FRUIT UNTIL 1 DAY AFTER SPRAYING

CAUTION: DO NOT spray on Glen Retreat mandarins. DO NOT allow chemical containers or spray to get into drains, sewers, streams or ponds.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in the closed, original container in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. Do not store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty container by wrapping in paper, placing in plastic bag and putting in garbage.
