HOW CERA TRAP WORKS

Cera Trap contains a unique protein based liquid solution that is very attractive to both female and male fruit flies. Once the lid is removed from the bottle, the smell of the liquid lures the fruit flies into the specially designed trap. Unable to escape they remain in the trap and drown in the liquid.

The organic liquid contains no pesticides and will continue to work even after many flies are drowned in the liquid.

WORKS ON

Apples, Apricots, Blueberries, Cherries, Grapes, Grapefruit, Guava, Lemons, Limes, Mandarin, Mangoes, Oranges, Passionfruit, Pawpaw, Peaches, Pears, Plums, Nectarines

TARGETS:

Queensland and Mediterranean Fruit Flies. Works on the female and breaks the breeding cycle.

WHEN TO USE:

It is important to control fruit fly numbers before they start attacking the fruit. Cera Trap should be hung in trees when the fruit are small & still developing. Ideally hang the traps when fruit reaches approximately one third of its final size.

HOW TO USE:

Apply 1 trap per tree or 1 trap every 20m² when trees are touching.

Step 1

Remove lid carefully and screw on hanging apparatus. Wipe any liquid that may spill on the outside of the jar (we want the flies to go inside it).

Step 2

Insert a wire or a cable tie through the top of the hanging apparatus to attach the unit to the tree.

For best results, position it on the northern side of the tree and approximately 1.5m above the ground.

For tall trees, you may need to place it higher to keep the trap in the foliage.

Step 3

Remove the Cera Trap from the tree once all of the liquid has evaporated (usually lasts 3-4 months)

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Store in the closed original container in a well-ventilated area, building or room as cool as possible, away from children, animals and or food. Prior to use Do NOT store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. As contents are environmentally friendly the container and contents can be disposed of by wrapping in paper, placing in a plastic bag and putting in garbage. The Cera Trap liquid attractant is suitable for composting.
