



SUPERGREEN LAWN FERTILISER

Application Methods

Sprinkle by hand or fertiliser spreader

Firstly, give the lawn a light watering. Then apply evenly 15g per square metre of lawn. After application, water in thoroughly.

Watering Can

Dissolve 150g of Supergreen in 9 litres of water. Apply evenly over 10 square metres of lawn using a watering can with a rose attachment.

When To Apply

Supergreen should be applied to the lawn between September and April. For maximum benefit apply every 4-6 weeks.

Application Tips

- 1 cup holds approximately 150g of Supergreen.
- For consistent growth it is important to apply Supergreen evenly over the lawn.
- Do not use on new lawns that are under 8 weeks old.
- Supergreen is a soluble fertiliser and will absorb moisture. To keep fertiliser in good condition, fold the top of the bag down and secure with a clip or clothes peg after use.
